**There will be a \$100 reduction in the enrollment fee and a \$25 reduction in the curriculum and technology fee if paid by the last day of the 2010-2011 school year.

Athletic and certain secondary elective course fees will be assessed upon student participation.

*There will be a 5% discount on tuition price if paid in full by the last day of the 2010-2011 school year.

**There will be a 3% discount on tuition price if paid in full by Friday, July 1, 2011.

Discounts are for tuition only. There are no discounts for fees. For discounted tuition rates, please contact our Accounts Receivable Office at 251-1997 ext. 310.

If pre-enrolled by the last day of the 2010-2011 school year, a multi-child discount of 20% is given to all younger siblings of currently enrolled students in Summit Christian Academy or Small World Learning Center.

A 10% multi-child discount is given to all younger siblings of new students and families that are not currently enrolled at Summit Christian Academy or Small World Learning Center.

Monthly payment schedule:

12-month schedule...First payment due June 1, 2011

10-month schedule...First payment due August 1, 2011

PLEASE NOTE:

Payments made thereafter are due on or before the first day of each month.

Monthly tuition must be paid by the first of each month. If tuition is not paid by the 10th of the month, a 10% late fee is assessed. We accept cash, check, money order, or MasterCard/Visa. A convenience fee may be assessed for all credit/debit card transactions.

If an account is not paid before the last business day of the month, the student may be suspended from school for non-payment of tuition. Students may be re-enrolled after the account has been brought current and the parents guarantee future incidents will not reoccur. All balances due to Summit Christian Academy (SCA), The Assembly at Broken Arrow, or the Lunch Program must be paid in full before SCA will accept a student's application for re-enrollment. There will be a re-enrollment fee of \$50 per student.

All balances due SCA, The Assembly at Broken Arrow, or the Lunch Program must be paid in full by the last day of school. Student records cannot be released to a third party (school district, scholarship service, medical facility, etc.) until all balances are paid.

Reasonable attempts to collect balances due will be made by SCA and The Assembly at Broken Arrow. If these attempts fail, or if there is an apparent attempt to defraud SCA or The Assembly at Broken Arrow, collection attempts will be handled by appropriate legal representation.
